




### Validation services

- Log in to the <u>BPAY Group Developer Portal</u> create an account if you don't have one already
- On the top navigation bar, select "API Documentation"
- Select the BPAY Payments API you would like to try

The following pages will guide you through each of the BPAY APIs:

- Retrieve BPAY Biller Details: look up Biller Code or Biller Name
- Validate BPAY Payment: send payment information to get it validated
- Generate BPAY Batch File: provide a list of BPAY payments to generate a batch file in a bank ready format for processing
- Generate BPAY CRN: provide Biller details and relevant parameters to generate a list of Customer Reference Numbers (CRNs or iCRNs)

**Note:** There is no need to create an App or Authorise a key when you want to try our APIs with the Developer Portal user interface.

**Developers:** Create an App with its Client ID and Secret, to perform your testing using Postman, on the Sandbox endpoint.

### Look up by Biller Name: Go to "API Documentation", select "Retrieve BPAY Biller Details"

On the left hand side, select Path "/biller (GET)"



2. Enter the sample Biller Names in the "searchText" request. Type in the exact value as it is case sensitive. Any other entry will return 404 Not Found.

Try with these Biller Names:

- harrison
- miller
- miller, page=2
- zyl
- C (returns error 400 Bad Request)

### Look up by Biller Code: Go to "API Documentation", select "Retrieve BPAY Biller Details"


On the left hand side, select Path "/biller/{billercode} (GET)"



2 Enter the sample Biller Codes in the "billerCode" request. Any other Biller Code will return 404 Not Found.

On the left hand side, select Path "/validatepayments (POST)"



Under Request Body (required), click "Example"



Copy the JSON request example to the clipboard using the "copy icon"

There is **only one** example to try Validate Payment

If any of the content in the request is changed, like Amount, payment method, TID.... the response will be **404 not found**

On the left hand side, select Path "/generatebatchfile (POST)"




Copy the JSON request example to the clipboard using the "copy icon"

There is **only one** example to try Generate Batch

If any of the content in the request is changed, the API response will be **404 Not Found** 

2. Under Request Body (required), click "Example"



On the right hand side, click in the Request body box, and select all of the text in the box – click anywhere in the text box, and press CTRL-A – the selection is highlighted in blue



### Go to "API Documentation", select "Generate BPAY CRN"

On the left hand side, select Path "/bills (POST)"



Copy the JSON request example to the clipboard using the "copy icon"

If you change any value in the Request body, you get a 404 not found error

On the right hand side, click in the **Request body** box, and select all of the text in the box – click anywhere in the text box, and press CTRL-A – the selection is highlighted in blue



2. Under Request Body (required), click "Example"



On the right hand side, you can specify **Request parameters**:

- Generate QR Code: true/false
- QR Code Image Format: JPG, PNG
- Include Amount: true/false

Paste the text of the request by pressing CTRL-V. The requests text shows in red.

### **Submit BPAY Payment**

- Log in to the <u>BPAY Group Developer Portal</u> create an account if you don't have one already
- On the top navigation bar, select "API Documentation"
- Select "Submit BPAY Payment" as highlighted

**Note**: the Submit BPAY Payment API has 3 instruction types:

- Payment code "05"
- Error Correction code "15"
- and Reversal code "25"

**Note:** There is no need to create an App or Authorise a key when you want to try our APIs with the Developer Portal user interface.






